## A LETTER FROM YOUR MINISTRY TEAM

### Turning points!

It is often hard to see turning points at the time. When nights are long and the weather wintery, it is often hard to appreciate that traditionally the first day of Spring was recognised as being the first of February (roughly half way between the shortest day of the year usually 21st December and the Spring equinox on 21st March when day and night are of equal length. Whilst the days may be getting longer, it was still cold and there was a way to go before longer days and warmer weather became clear!

In the Christian calendar this time of year also marks a turning point – one in which we stop looking back at Christmas and Epiphany and start looking forwards towards Good Friday and Easter. This turning point is called "Candlemas" and recalls the child Jesus being taken to the temple in Jerusalem.

Whilst in the temple, 40 days after the birth of Jesus, undergoing the rituals prescribed for mother and child, two elderly prophets, Simeon and Anna were met who predicted the mission of Jesus. The words of Simeon, recorded in chapter 2 of Luke's gospel, and known by the Latin words "Nunc Dimitis", remain part of the church's daily service of evening prayer to this day:

"...Sovereign Lord, as you have promised, you may now dismiss your servant in peace. For my eyes have seen your salvation, which you have prepared in the sight of all nations: a light for revelation to the Gentiles, and the glory of your people Israel..."

Words clearly signalling that Jesus mission was not just to the Jewish people, but to the whole wider world (known to the Jewish people as the Gentiles). This festival, which always took place 40 days after Christmas on 2<sup>nd</sup> February, became associated with the returning light. Families would take a candle to church which was blessed before the altar and often carried in procession before being retained in peoples houses for the coming year – and, accompanying prayer, lit at challenging times. It was from this ceremony that the name "Candlemas" emerged.

This year there will be a retelling of the encounter of Jesus, Mary and Joseph with Simeon and Anna on Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> February in our churches (times and churches in the list of services in this edition of Grapevine).

In the meantime, as we move on from celebrating Jesus birth at Christmas, to looking forward to celebrating all that he did for this world through his death on the cross and the hope we receive through his glorious resurrection - my hope and prayer is that the gradual increase in daylight at this turning point of the seasons, will be accompanied by a real increase of awareness in hearts and minds of the true light of life that is Jesus, the Light of the world. **Amen!**.

A prayer for Candlemas:
Lord Jesus Christ,
Light of the nations and glory of Israel:
Make your home among us,
And present us pure and holy
To your heavenly Father
Your god, and our God. Amen.





## Worlingham Community Hall Update No.12

Unfortunately, due to circumstances beyond the control of both ourselves (the Trustees) and the builders (Badger Builders), the roof was not completed before Christmas. This was because the delivery of required tiles was delayed as the tiles were not were not available. As a result the next inspection by our site agents (Allman Woodcock) had to be postponed until later in January, when we expect the tiles to be delivered and put in place. At the most recent meeting of the Trustees a draft copy of a 'Noise Abatement Plan' was discussed. The purpose of this is to minimise the impact of the hall upon local residents particularly when events are taking place within the hall. After discussion, some further suggestions were made and the amended plan will be reviewed at a later date.

Our submission for funding was despatched to the National Lottery earlier in January after considerable hard work composing the submission by a sub-group of the Trustees. We expect to hear the result in approximately six to eight weeks. However other financial donations, for which we are most grateful, been made by Adnams Brewery from their Community Trust fund (towards the cost of the hall's hearing loop), from Broadwater Mouldings and from Worlingham Farms. A generous donation has been made by East Suffolk Council who are financing the provision and installation of a 'Beverage Point' to be located in the entrance hall. This facility, quite independent of the kitchen and bar facilities, will be available to all hall users throughout the day.

We continue to seek volunteers to join the Community Hall's Management Committee. A number of local residents have already expressed interest in being involved. We expect that the management committee would be in place prior to completion and handover of the hall. They would take responsibility for the day to day running, covering such issues as finance, publicity, bookings, maintenance and other areas to be defined. It may read like an onerous and time consuming task but the committee would initially have the support and guidance of the trustees.
