

As the children are now back at school and the summer bargains are sold, shops are turning now to Halloween. I noticed a whole aisle the other day in a local shop dedicated to all things spooky! But shops are also recognising that not everyone wants a spooky decoration, some would rather have an autumnal wreath or a decorative pumpkin together with a friendly gonk/gnome type character sitting atop!

Whether you love Halloween or can't stand autumn in general, there is still beauty 🕋 to admire in the changing colours of the season. My dear old dad didn't like autumn – to him it foretold of cold winters and reminded him of hard times in his youth. But even he would grudgingly agree that the colours were rather spectacular! 


Wild Church


Wild Church got off to a flying start in August, looking at the story of the Good Samaritan and creating our own floral printed bandages/bandanas!

This year we are again holding a Grand Christmas Draw to raise money for the five churches in the Beccles Parish.






"I made a claim for Pension Credit and got money off my new glasses"



You might be eligible for Pension Credit if you've reached State Pension age. Pension Credit doesn't just top up your income, it comes with extra advantages:

- free NHS dental treatment, help towards the cost of glasses and transport to hospital
- help with housing costs (rent or mortgage interest)
- a free TV Licence if you are 75 or over
- Winter Fuel Payment of up to £300
- Warm Home Discount of £150
- A Cold Weather Payment of £25 per day in periods of very cold weather
- Extra money if you care for someone (up to £45.60 per week), or if you have a disability (up to £81.50 per week)

You can apply if you own your own home and may be eligible even if you have some savings. You have nothing to lose by applying. If you've previously been turned down, you can still make a new claim each year. For more information, or to apply, call 0800 99 1234 or visit www.gov.uk/pension-credit
